BYLAWS OF THE BOARD

ORGANIZATION

Standing Board Committees

The creation and composition of standing committees shall be established by the full membership of the Board of Education.

In addition to any board member appointed pursuant to the creation of a standing committee, every board member is entitled to request appointment to any standing committee by the president of the board, which shall not be withheld; however, a majority of the committee members approved by the full Board of Education shall constitute a quorum for committee meetings to be held and action on recommendations to the board to be taken.

Standing committees shall also perform any other functions which may be assigned by the president on behalf of the board.

Within thirty days of being elected to the office, the president of the board shall appoint chairpersons, and assistant chairpersons as needed, to the standing committees of the board.

Each chairperson will work in concert with appropriate administrators to bring matters of the school system to the attention of the board for action.
